



Putt Putt Pub Tournament FAQ 's - March 17th at 11 AM

Where does the event start?

On the morning of the 17th, all teams will report to the Apple Lounge where they will receive their hole assignment for a shotgun start as well as rules for the tournament and a chance to purchase Mulligans. Final registration table will open at 10:00 am. Completion of the waiver is required prior to being able to participate. Paperwork can be printed from PuttPuttPubWH.com and completed prior to registration to expedite final registration.

What locations are participating?

Apple Lounge, Caribbean Bay, Tanner's, Old Man Frank's, Central Tavern, Games on Tap, Jessie's, Jensen's Corner Bar, & Idle Zone

Where is the After Party, Auction, and Awards?

After each team finishes playing all nine holes they should report to the Apple Lounge, which is also the 9th Hole by 4:00 PM. No later than 5:00 PM, we will announce the cash prize winners, the best hole, and best dressed.

Do I have to dress up/wear a costume?

Dressing up is optional. Costumes can be as individual or team and are not limited to golf oriented

What are the cash prizes?

First place team will receive \$250, second place team will receive \$200, and third place team will receive \$150. There are additional non cash prizes as well.

What if there is a tie?

In the event of a tie, we will go into sudden death at the ninth hole (Apple Lounge). Each team captain (from the teams that are tied) will shoot the hole. The player with the best score wins (No mulligans can be used here). If there is another tie, we will move to another player from each team and so forth. If all four team members tie the other team(s), we will result to a coin flip with the team that registered first calling the flip.

How much does it cost to participate?

The cost is \$150 for a team of 4. This equates to \$37.50 per person; however, only team registration is allowed and no individual registration is available. If a team has less than 4 people on the day of the event, a player on the team can substitute and make a second attempt at the hole.

How does the transportation work from each location?

If your team does not have a designated driver to drive to each location, transportation to each hole is available. In order to qualify for the transportation, your team must have both requested transportation and repaid the full \$150 registration fee by March 12th.

How does scoring work?

We will be using a best hole format. In a best hole tournament, all members of each team play their own balls on each hole. At the completion of the hole, the lowest score among all team members serves as the team score. If there are four members on a team, and on the first [hole](#) those four golfers score 4, 7, 6 and 5, the team score is 4, because that is the *best hole score* among the four players. There will be a representative from each participating location that will certify the score for each team. If a golfer hits a hole in one or if a subsequent golfer exceeds the prior team members strokes, the rest of the team members are not required to continue playing but can do so if they would like to.

Can I have a Do-Over?

It'll cost you...Each player gets one chance at each hole. After the score is recorded, additional attempts can be made if no one else is waiting; however, the score will not be altered. At the registration kick off, players will be able to purchase a mulligan or do-over for \$5 before the event starts. The mulligan must be turned into the representative at the hole where it is being used. There is a limit of four mulligans per person and only one mulligan can be used per person per hole.

Do I need to bring my own ball or putter?

No. You are welcome to bring your own equipment; however, each location will be equipped with a putter and balls for each player to use.

Are any drinks included with my registration fee?

Each registered golfer will receive beer at each location, compliments of Bernie Little Distributors. Some locations may offer specials created just for the Putt Putt Pub golfers.

What is the Women's Resource Center?

The Women's Resource Center is a 501 (c)(3), non-profit organization that has been serving Polk, Highland, and Hardee counties since 1984. Their mission is to provide a variety of services for women and their families in crisis. Where do I buy tickets?

Tickets/Registration can be purchased from Apple Lounge, or on Event Brite as well as some of the locations. In addition, tickets are also for sale at TECHMATE, located on 3rd street in Winter Haven Monday through Friday 9:30-6:00 and Saturday 9:00-2:00.

Can I get a refund if I can't make it?

No refunds will be allowed; however, you can transfer your registration to someone else if something should happen and you are unable to make it.

Bar Specific Information

Idle Zone has asked that no alcoholic drinks be brought into their establishment as they do not have a liquor license.

Transportation Information

If you indicated you needed transportation and finalized payment and registration prior to March 12th, you are eligible to utilize the transportation included in the ticket price. You will receive a blue armband to indicate your ticket includes transportation. We have three fifteen passenger vans donated for the event by Excel Athletics with three volunteer drivers to facilitate your safe transportation during the day. Please do not bring open alcoholic beverages into the vehicles and please refrain from eating while riding from location to location. Each van will be assigned three teams and all three teams will play each hole before the van leaves for the next location (with the exception of the Lake Howard locations as well as Jessie's and Jensen's, as transportation is not needed between those locations). As your drivers are donating their time, if they do a good job, feel free to show them some appreciation by tipping them.
